Network background and goals

Background

- the E-ELT is a facility that is expected to operate for 30 years.
- Based on the VLT experience, a key to its success is an <u>upgrade plan for</u> the second generation of instruments behind those conceived for 1st light. Achievable with the coordination and support of the key European institutes, plus the development of new groups.

Goals

- Given the framework set by the scientific requirements of the E-ELT instrument studies for 1^{st} light, the goal of this network is to identify the parameter space of the upgrade path in the area of wide field imaging (WFI).
- WFI@E-ELT: going beyond those applications which require very high Strehl ratio on single sources over a very small field, e.g. imaging of planets.
