ESO Science Archive Facility – Open Data for Open Science

The Science Archive Facility at ESO provides access to all the data obtained at its La Silla and Paranal Observatories, as well as by ALMA and APEX, and enables their subsequent dissemination and use by the scientific community. Since 1992 this petabyte-sized repository provides a permanent storage for raw data and a selection of science-ready data products. The principal investigators of successful proposals for observing time on ESO telescopes have exclusive access to their scientific data for one year. After this period the data and their processed products become available to the community at large. All data in the ESO Science Archive Facility are distributed under a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International license (CC BY-4.0).
